

#### Listening

- B1 Can read straightforward factual texts on subjects related to their field and interest with a satisfactory level of comprehension.

#### **Speaking**

- A2 Can give a simple description or presentation of people, living or working conditions, daily routines likes/dislikes, etc. as a short series of simple phrases and sentences linked into a list.

#### Writing
