
Dear IELTS candidate,

Aiming at making your registration for IELTS easier, we are happy to provide you with Guidance so you can upload the electronic copy of your ID.

Please read below the instructions on how you can upload your identification document:

At step 5 of your online application,



Under "where are you currently studying English" the following facility appears:



Clicking on the Browse button, you can select your scanned document for upload.

NOTE: Please make sure before you reach this point:-

- √ You have scanned your Identification document.
- ✓ Scanning is clear and document is easily readable.
- ✓ Both sides are in one page.

Your scanned document must contain (Either Passport or National ID {RegistroGeral}):


- Your ID or Passport number

- Your photograph
- Your ID or Passport expiry date
- Your signature


Valid Documents accepted for IELTS:

Please note that "<u>Only Following Documents will be Accepted as Valid document</u>" for IELTS registration.

Points to Remember:

Please **<u>DO NOT</u>** upload your Photo or Driving License or any other ID proof except ID's mentioned above.

How to upload the documents

The scanned document must be smaller than 1600 by 1600 pixels and the file size should be 1.5 MB or less.

Only **JPEG**, **GIF** or **PNG** files are supported at present.


How to make picture files smaller:






You can use Microsoft Office Picture Manager; this is part of the standard Windows Office package (like Word, Excel etc.):


Open your JPEG, GIF or PNG with Picture Manager and select "Edit Pictures"



If the upload is successful the document will be displayed above the Edit, Remove and Browse buttons.




If you wish you can then perform some basic editing of your image by clicking on the Edit button or on the image itself. This opens the Edit window where the image can be rotated, cropped and resized.



Clicking on 'Ok' will save any changes you have made. Once you are happy with the image you can proceed with your registration as normal.

If not, you can click on the Remove button underneath the image and upload another.

Before the application is submitted the summary screen is displayed but now it will include the uploaded image and the option to go back and change it along with any of the other details.



After you pay the bar coded document (boleto bancário) your application will be checked against the photo and if your document is accepted you will receive an email from noreply.ors@britishcouncil.org confirming your application.

If however the document is rejected (mainly because the above document criteria are not met), then you will receive an email with a link to enable you to upload a replacement document.
